	D.	Transitions Program ** The Transition Program is a special education program that is offered to students with disabilities who require continued support after completion of their four years of high school. These students may need further instruction and guided practice in the areas of work-based learning, independent living, and community access to further their independence as determined by the student's IEP team. The students in the program have a range of abilities and the goal of the program is to help each student reach their highest level of independence in these areas. We currently contract with SEDOL for the Transition Program, however we are making the recommendation to provide these educational services in-district. This recommendation is based on our desire to provide these educational services locally and provide students the benefit of work-based learning experiences in their own community. Based on current enrollment, the take-back of this program will result in a net savings to the district of approximately \$139,000. Recommend approval of a district provided transitions program effective with the 2020/21 school year.	677
	Ε.	Student Residency Procedures ** Students have the right to attend school in the district in which they reside with their	

parent or legal guardian. With an increasing trend of residency-related cases requiring investigation, we are recommending a change to student residency

procedures effective with the 2020/21 school year. With the purchase of a subscription-based residency validation program, CLEAR from Thomson Reuters, we can ensure we are enrolling and educating only those students who reside indistrict. This recommendation comes to you after considering many options, including returning to an in-person or online residency process. The CLEAR program will provide us the opportunity to verify residency, through reliable public and proprietary information, prior to enrollment and periodically throughout their four years. The site-license will allow us to run residency reports once per year for all students, prior to the start of a school year at a cost of \$234 per month. The site license to perform unlimited searching throughout the school year (new students, transfer students, returned mail, etc.) will be \$289 per month. Both require a 12month subscription. With a cost to educate a student at approximately \$15,000 per year, we feel this is a sound investment to strengthen our residency measures and ensure all students reside in the district. With approval, parents and guardians will be made aware of the new procedures. Recommend approval of a subscriptionbased service with CLEAR for both the residency batch process and unlimited searching throughout the school year at a combined cost of \$523 per month.

F. Illinois Science Assessment

Illinois school districts are required to administer a science assessment to students in grades 5, 8 and 11. The format of the test and the students that need to be tested have changed significantly from last year. The new test is a series of 3 online assessments, with each test session estimated to take 50-55 minutes to complete between test administration and student time on task. There was not an easy solution to schedule testing as juniors are not all taking the same science class and there are some juniors not currently enrolled in a science course. In order to minimize impact to both testing and non-testing students, juniors will test in groups of 100-120 in both the morning and afternoon on regular school days. We will complete the majority of testing on March 3 and 4, with testing for Tech Campus students and those needing accommodations on March 2 and 5. Participation in the Illinois Science Assessment is required and we must achieve participation of 95% of students eligible for testing.

VI. Business Affairs

A. Cybersecurity Threat Assessment **

77

The rise of cybersecurity attacks on schools has made the news across the country, with several recent ones in Illinois. As a pre-emptive action, we are recommending that the district contract with an independent outside company to do a comprehensive cybersecurity threat assessment. Tom Furlan and I met with three different companies who offered different options. I have attached information on them. We recommend the district contract with CDW Government, LLC for a Rapid Security Assessment at a cost of \$18,900.

B. 2020/21 71-Passenger Gasoline Bus Lease **

Midwest Transit Equipment provided us with a municipal lease proposal for the 2020/21 school year that had a significant increase over last year. We began to look at options for keeping costs down, including moving to a two-year lease, and looking at other bus company options. We are looking to make a change this year from Midwest Transit to Central States Bus Sales. The lease is for 2021 Blue-Bird 71 passenger school buses at a cost of \$15,696 each. We currently lease 23 buses. Additionally, we are recommending a two-year lease, and the price remains the same with Central States Bus Sales. I included comparable information for your review. Recommend leasing 23, 71- passenger gasoline buses from Central States Bus Sales, Inc for two years.

C. 2020 Micro-Bird Gasoline 24-Passenger Lift, Three-Year Bus Lease **

The bus we lease with a wheelchair lift is also at the end of a three-year lease with Midwest Transit Equipment. We approached this lease in the same manner as the 71-passenger yellow buses. We received quotes from both Midwest and Central States Bus Sales. The quoted prices are listed on the attached document. Recommend leasing a 2020 Micro-Bird Gasoline 24 Passenger Lift for 3 years from Central States Bus Sales, Inc.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Student Recognition

Dr. Sefcik asked Emma Lancaster, in the presence of her parents Jude and Kristina Lancaster, to join her at the podium to be introduced as the December Student of the Month. Dr. Sefcik detailed her academic accomplishments including induction into the National Honor Society during her sophomore year, qualifying for Honor Roll each semester, and her impressive 4.843 GPA. Her extracurricular activities are Spring Musical, Fall Play, and Choir, where she was Section Leader for 2 years, Rookie of the Year in 2016, and awarded for Musical Excellence, Anthem Singers, honored with Heralding Trumpet Award, and Speech Team serving as Captain for 2 years. Community service projects include NHS service, volunteering at Big Hollow, and Grant Junior Bulldogs Football games. She works as a babysitter and enjoys following theater, writing poetry and short stories, reading, playing piano, ukulele, and guitar, reviews movies and TV, and she is a proud ally and advocate of LGBTQ+ rights. She plans to pursue a degree in psychology and criminology and has been awarded the Presidential Excellence Scholarship at Bradley University where she has been accepted into the Honors Program, but she is keeping her options open.

Dr. Sefcik called attention to the video where she introduces the November Student of the Month, Luke Bedrosian and read his profile that he is the son of Jack and Jennifer Bedrosian of Round Lake. His academic achievements include induction into NHS during sophomore year, earned Honor Roll and Scholars' List status each semester, he has been enrolled in several AP classes, one dual credit class, and passed all six AP exams. He was named NLCC All-Scholar. Social Studies Golden Globe winner, and nominated for Boys' State. He currently holds an outstanding 5.198 GPA. His extracurriculars include 4 years of Football, earning MVP, Desire Award, Team Captain, Varsity starter since sophomore year, and NLCC All-Conference 1st Team; 4 years of Basketball, earning the Hustle Award; and the Track and Math Teams each year. He is a founding member of the Computer Science Club. He volunteers with NHS and he is a youth football junior coach, and head coach of the 4th grade feeder basketball team. He is also a Big Dawg Mentor and Math Lab Tutor. He works as a lifeguard during the summer and is a host at Walker Bros. Pancake House. He enjoys researching space exploration, math, physics, travel & culture, technology, and history. He plans to earn a degree in Aerospace Engineering and is assessing his university options such as MIT, Stanford, Purdue, and University of Illinois where he was recently accepted. His career aspiration is to further space exploration and colonization at SpaceX or NASA.

Both Students' of the Month were presented a certificate to commemorate the honor and the audience and Board applauded their achievements.

Fall Athletic Accomplishments

Dr. Sefcik asked Mr. Tom Ross to detail the Fall Athletic Accomplishments for 2019. The sports included in the report were Boys and Girls Cross Country, Football, Boys Golf, Girls Golf, Boys Soccer, Girls Tennis, and Girls Volleyball.

Future Ready Update

Dr. Sefcik asked Mr. Greg Urbaniak, Director of Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment to provide the Board with the Future Ready Schools Initiative update. He distributed a handout with the 21st Century classroom update: 45 classrooms have been upgraded over the past 3 years, 10 more are scheduled next year, and gave a breakdown by department for the future upgrades. The TSI Program is going well, including the loaner system, charging towers/locations, and certifications. He then spoke on the Future Ready Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment Gear Assessment. The original assessment was done in October 2016, the last Staff Gear Assessment was done in November 2016-January 2017, and the new staff gear assessment given in

December 2019. He explained it rates readiness in five major areas and each area is on a five point scale. Finally, he provided comparison scores on the District assessment, the 2016/17 Staff Assessment, and the 2019 Staff Assessment.

Student Performance Update

Dr. Sefcik asked Mr. Urbaniak to deliver information on student performance on the Fall 2019 SAT Suite of Assessment Testing, including scoring information, benchmark score information, score and benchmark performances for the classes of 2021, 2022, and 2023. Historical Scoring and Benchmark Performances were included for the Class of 2021 and 2022.

Student Privileges

Dr. Sefcik turned it over to Mr. Schmidt to talk about the Student Privilege Exploratory Committee's recommendation to pilot the flexible use of study hall time for senior students that meet certain criteria. Allowing those senior students that qualify to choose the Library or Senior Café during their study hall, can reinforce positive student behaviors. Senior students will have to hold a "C" or better in all classes, 90% or above attendance rate, and a low disciplinary referral rate as reported for each progress reporting period.

Resolution to Adopt E-learning

Dr. Sefcik stated that the State of Illinois now provides schools with the flexibility to utilize E-learning days in lieu of emergency days up to a maximum of 5 e-learning days annually. Faculty and students are now in possession of a district provided computer and have the ability to extend educational experiences outside of the classroom. The district has been working over the past 7 months to design an E-learning Plan, which is presented here this evening. Some of the highlights were listed and the Board was informed that the district will provide a practice E-learning day when school is in session. A Professional Development library will be developed for use by non-licensed staff to utilize on E-learning days along with other options. The Board asked about the timeline for implementation and was informed that the earliest implementation date would be 30 days after Board approval.

Dr. Sefcik informed the Board that the Transition Program is a special education program that is offered to students with disabilities who require continued support after completion of their four years of high school. The program provides instruction and guidance in the areas of work-based learning, independent living, and community access to further their independence as determined by the student's IEP team. This program is currently contracted with SEDOL and we are providing a proposed plan to offer these educational services in-district. Mrs. Sonders, Director of Special Education said that seven students were currently in the SEDOL program and approximately 4-5 LOP students will require the Transition Program each year. There is value to have students here and there is community business interest.

Residency – Informational Only

Dr. Sefcik asked Dr. Miller to explain the residency process currently in use and how the District can benefit through the use of the CLEAR residency validation program from Thomson Reuters. They are able to access public and proprietary information that is not available to us. 12-month subscription cost information was provided.

Transition Program Overview

The Transition Program is a special education program that is offered to students with disabilities who require continued support after completion of their four years of high school. These students may need further instruction and guided practice in the areas of work-based learning, independent living, and community access to further their independence as determined by the student's IEP team. The students in the program have a range of abilities and disabilities and the goal of the program is to help each student reach their highest level of independence in these areas.

Each student participates in a curriculum that is adapted and appropriate to his/her needs, interests, and abilities. The Transition Program offers a range of experiences, allowing students to continue to learn and apply functional academics, self-advocacy/self-determination, problem solving skills, social emotional skills, and speech and language skills.

The experience in the Transition Program allows students to make progress towards their IEP goals and post-secondary transition outcomes. Before exiting the program, the students and families gain an understanding of adult services and how to access these resources for life-long support. In collaboration with families and the community, we prepare students to be productive, integral, and valued members of society.

Transition Program Schedule

Our Transition Program follows the Grant Community High School District 124 yearly calendar (including Flex Schedule, Activity Schedule, Early Release and Non-Attendance Days). Please refer to the District's main webpage for additional information.

We deliver instruction through a block schedule that focuses on the development of community access, independent living, and work-based learning skills needed for a more independent adult life.

Transition Program Support Structure

The Transition Program offers support based on students' abilities, needs and post-secondary goals. The program will focus on providing support in the areas of independent living, work-based learning and community access, while promoting independence.

Dear Esteemed Members of the Board of Education,

Each year, our Math Team must participate in a Regional competition to qualify for Sectionals and State competitions. The regional competition radius is quite wide for Math Team and we have been assigned DeKalb, Illinois at Northern Illinois University for the last several years. The Math Team contest checkin process begins in the 8:00am hour, requiring us to leave by 6:00am on Saturday to arrive to the contest on-time. With the size of the team heading to the Regional competition (almost 30 students), we would need two activity buses to transport all of our participants. Activity buses would be preferred as it is roughly a 12-hour day for a bus driver and departure times after the contest can vary depending on the timing of the awards ceremony/student recognition presentation at the end of the day. Being that the event takes place in February, winter weather conditions could also significantly lengthen the travel times, putting the Math Team at risk of being late to check-in on Saturday morning.

Since the Regional Contest can qualify students and teams for state-level competition, we wish to put our best foot forward. If this trip is approved, student competitors will be on-time, well-rested and eat a quality breakfast prior to the competition. As such, the Math Team is requesting to travel after school on Friday afternoon to DeKalb, Illinois, and spend the evening in the area of our competition venue. Students would depart Grant Community High School at 3:30pm on Friday, February 21, 2020 and return to campus at 6:00pm on Saturday, February 22, 2020. The team is requesting approval for a one-night stay in the NIU area.

Students participating in the Regional contest will be contributing funds to the Math Team activity fund for the cost of the rooms. The Math Team will provide funding for a Friday evening dinner. The hotel provides breakfast on Saturday morning. The students will bring funds for lunch on Saturday afternoon. The only additional costs that will be incurred on the District side will be fuel reimbursements for the activity buses.

In addition to approving the overnight trip, the Math Team would also like to request an additional chaperone to drive an activity bus and to assist with supervising the team. Typically, one adult sponsor from each participating district is required to contribute in the tabulation room or proctoring an exam. The additional help ensures that our students are always under direct adult supervision throughout the day on Saturday. Sponsor Eric Weinmann will be accompanied by another designee to ensure that two chaperones are present throughout the entire trip.

Thank you again for your time and consideration. You have been so supportive of our student groups and we'd love the opportunity to bring home a sectional or state trophy to Grant Community High School.

Board of Education Meeting January 2020 Principal Report, Jeremy Schmidt

SAT Prep Class

Enrollment for our SAT Preparation Class began on January 13 and is open through January 31. This is our fourth year running this class which is designed to prepare students to meet their personal SAT goals. The classes are led by Grant Math, English, and Science teachers. The class combines digital tools endorsed by the College Board along with traditional teacher instruction. The two-hour class will meet from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm on Tuesday evenings from February 4 through March 31. The first seven classes are structured as instructional lab sessions, and the final class is an optional small group study. One of our goals in providing this opportunity, is to make sure that cost is not a limiting factor for students. The total cost is \$80, and if the students attend all of the first seven instructional lab sessions, they will receive a \$40 refund.

Illinois Youth Survey

We are preparing to administer the Illinois Youth Survey (IYS) on February 20, 2020 to all sophomores and seniors. This is our second year administering this free, state-wide survey that is funded by the Illinois Department of Human Services and supported by the Lake County Health Department. The IYS is designed to gather information about a variety of health and social indicators including substance use patterns and attitudes of Illinois' youth. Designed to be administered every other year to 8th, 10th, and 12th graders, the survey takes 30-45 minutes. We will administer the survey electronically using Chromebooks to seniors enrolled in all levels of English 12 and all sophomores enrolled in World History. Benefits of the survey include providing: figures required for state and national funding of grants, comparative data among the national, state, and county results, and data to assess local Student Service needs.

Eighth Grade Enrollment Night

On January 6, mailings were sent to incoming eighth grade families. This mailing initiated the enrollment process and invites families to Eighth Grade Enrollment Night. The mailing includes: a welcome letter, Course Recommendations/Placements, Electronic Network Access Authorization, required Health Information, and a Home Language Survey. During Eighth Grade Enrollment Nights, families meet their school counselor, become acquainted with school policies, select elective courses, begin the enrollment process, and learn about extracurricular activities. This year our Enrollment Nights are January 22 and January 23.

February Institute Day

The planning for our February 14 Institute Day is well underway. The administrative team, in coordination with instructional coaches and teacher leaders, have been working diligently to plan a full day of professional development for all certified staff. The day's activities will maintain our focus on instructional commitment to PLT's and working to find the most effective ways to reteach imperative skills and reassess student learning. Additionally, the PBIS team will share data and further develop our staff capacity, and teachers will participate in ALICE training led by our Safety Team to

prepare for implementation next year. Lastly, the Student Services Team along with several administrators will be participating the state-mandated Threat Assessment Training.

Summer Exploration Classes

We are looking forward to piloting a new summer opportunity for sophomore, junior, and senior students this year. Grant Summer Exploration 2020 will provide students the opportunity to experience fun and engaging mini-courses for a week. These mini-courses are designed to be camp-like in that they are not for credit but will provide experiences that can't or don't happen during the schoolyear.

Summer Exploration Classes will be taught by Grant teachers who are passionate about their content. Classes will run the week of May 26 – May 29, and, depending on the class, will be 2 to 4 ½ hours. The cost of the classes will range from \$10 - \$40 dollars which will be used to offset material costs and \$50 paid to each teacher. Each minicourse has a 12–15 student maximum. Transportation is not provided.

The five classes we are offering are: "Drawing with Mr. Austin or Observing the Everyday," "Introduction to Digital Electronics with Mr. Anderson," "Forensics Summer Course with Ms. Lev," "Ceramic Totems with Mr. Carlson," and "Cultural Painting with Ms. Zegler and Ms. Harker."

We hope this opportunity appeals to the whole spectrum of students: from those who have never before experienced these types of classes to those more veteran students who want to expand their skills.

Coffee Cart

Joree Morris and Jessica Mitchell, Special Education Learning Opportunity Program (LOP) teachers, along with Tina Sonders, Special Education Director, are coordinating a new experience for our LOP students. They are planning on setting up a coffee cart station run by students who will be selling coffee for Grant staff on a weekly basis out of the teacher's work room. Chris Carlson, Art teacher, has worked with Starbucks in Volo to get free Starbucks coffee that will be sold to staff for \$1.00. This is a great opportunity for our LOP students to get workplace-like experience, develop interpersonal skills, and further establish themselves into the Bulldog community
